Responsible Pet Owners

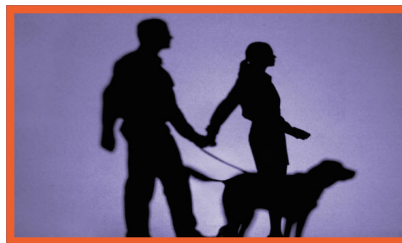
Taking responsibility for the liability and behavior of our pets is part of being a pet owner.

OAIA advocates that all pet owners build the skills and knowledge to be responsible pet owners. Pets don't understand what humans want and learning to communicate with your pet through training classes and understanding pet behavior is key to improving the relationship between the pet and their owner.

Pet owners should also understand the laws and regulations in owning a pet. Not only do pet owners have a responsibility to keep their pet healthy and safe but also to make sure others are safe from their pet. OAIA offers education in understanding local and state laws to be sure each pet owner understands their liabilities and their rights.

Responsible Breeders

OAIA works to offer education to animal/pet breeders. The position of OAIA is all breeders should provide information so that potential animal owners understand what is involved in pet care and are informed about the type of animal they have chosen. The responsibility of the breeder does not end when the pet owner takes the animal home. Breeders should provide continued follow along services such as resources for health, training and problem solving as a part of their customer service package.
